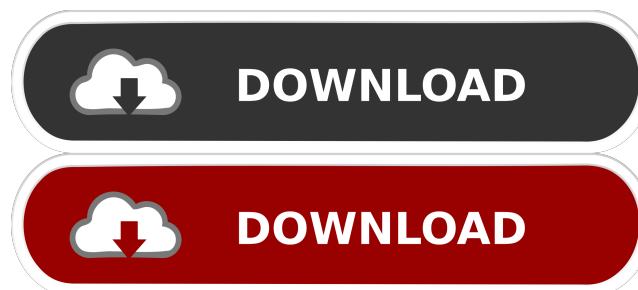

ArcGIS Desktop folder structure, as well as a more detailed outline of help topics. The outline of help topics is represented in the form of a table of contents (TOC), which you may use to navigate the help system. Figure 4.1: Adding help for ArcGIS for Desktop

Adding help for ArcGIS for Desktop requires a web server and a default help page that contains a link to the web server. To add help for ArcGIS for Desktop, follow these steps: 1. Start ArcGIS for Desktop and open Help. 2. From the Main Menu, select Help > Add Help. 3. In the Add Help dialog, enter the URL for your help web server in the Server URL field. 4. Click the Browse button to display the folder that contains the default help page. 5. Locate the Default.htm file and click Open. 6. Click the Finish button to add the file to the Help and to add the help topic to the Help TOC. When you add help for ArcGIS for Desktop, you can include help for ArcGIS Explorer, ArcMap, and ArcCatalog. After you add help for ArcGIS for Desktop, the Help TOC displays a link to your help site. Adding help for ArcGIS Explorer can be accomplished in the same way as adding help for ArcGIS for Desktop. Adding help for ArcMap and ArcCatalog requires that you edit the Default.htm file, which is located in the Help directory. The default help page contains a link to your help site. Adding help for ArcMap and ArcCatalog requires a web server and a link to the default help page. 1. Start ArcMap and open Help. 6. Click the Edit button next to the File Description field and edit the file to describe the topic that is included with the
